About the role/what we are looking for

We are seeking an enthusiastic individual who understands the importance of strong governance, bringing innovative ideas and enthusiasm to help deliver services that enhance the lives of vulnerable people in the community. The Treasurer is an important and valuable part of the Trustee Board assisting in monitoring, understanding and communicating the accounts and budgets to the Board. The Treasurer should be able to highlight any improvements or risks for the financial wellbeing of the Calthorpe.

Main duties

- Ensure compliance with ongoing accounting best practice, policies, regulations and effective financial procedures
- Review and provide advice on the necessary financial reports/returns, accounts and audits delivered to the Board
- Working with the Director and Chair in providing firm governance and strategic financial direction
- Provide guidance to the Board on financial matters
- Brainstorm the financial implications of any new initiatives
- Chair the financial sub-committee (if it is required)

Experience and qualities required

- Qualified accountant or demonstrable financial experience
- Experience within the charity sector desirable but not mandatory
- Proven ability to communicate effectively and explain financial information in its simplest forms
- Analytical and evaluation skills are paramount and ability to demonstrate balanced sound judgement
- Compliance with the legal duties, responsibilities and liabilities of trusteeship
- Passionate about the third sector
